eCloud – project abstract I

Designed to establish a cloud-based system for Europeana and its aggregators

- to provide new content and metadata,
- a new linked storage system,
- new platform for researchers Europeana Research
- 30 million items by 2015



eCloud - project abstract II

→ Key objectives:

- access, through Europeana, to 1.1m new metadata records and 5m research focussed items
- a cloud based and cost-efficient infrastructure
- the legal, strategic and economic issues of a cloud-based system
- a consensus on the advantages of a cloud based solution
- development of Europeana Research platform
- encourage research that exploits digitised content in Europeana



7 work packages

WP 4: Ingestion of Content and Metadata Development

- → Objectives are:
 - Bring new metadata and content from new and existing partners into Europeana
 - EDM enhancement
 - Linked Open Data
 - Improve the contextualisation of objects in Europeana



WP 4: Ingestion of Content and Metadata Development

- → Description of work and role of partners:
 - Task 1: ingestion of metadata
 - Task 2: ingestion of content directly into the cloud
 - Task 3: work on metadata enrichment methods
 - Task 4: evolving EDM for research content (eCloud metadata working group)



HAZU in WP 4

- → Bringing new metadata and content (images and text) from the repository of HAZU <u>dizbi.hazu.hr</u>
- → Images include plaster casts, copies of sculptures, photographs, postcards, paintings etc. 833 items;
- → Text: 1309 vols. (8637 articles)



HAZU in WP 4

- → HAZU metadata
 - UNIMARC (needs to be compared with EDM)
 - some collections without metadata (manuscripts etc.)
 - the authority files have to be implemented in all collections
 - some collections have very detailed descriptions katalozi
 - complex structure of the metadata <u>Monumenta</u>
 - all metadata should be verified

Opis: Jurjev kip Milosrđa, akt u gotovo naravnoj veličini, u kojemu je srednjevjekovnu ikonografiju Milosrđa - predstavljenu kao ženu golih grudi koja doji dvoje (tuđe) djece – približio tipu ženskog akta antičke Venere, ali i više od toga: ostvario je realistički oblikovano potpuno nago tijelo žene, dokidajući norme srednjevjekovnog stida, držeći se renesansnog gesla "ništa ljudsko nije mi strano". No, najoriginalnije je Jurjevo rješenje u tome što je umjesto dvoje simetrično postavljene djece komponirao čitav prizor s čak petero dječačića koji se u žarkoj dječjoj ljubavi "veru" po tijelu žene. Uz vjernu modelaciju i proporcije dječjih tijela, majstorski rješene pokrete, Juraj uspješno izražava dječju psihologiju: prvi, desno uz nogu jest "mrki" zato se osjeća zapostavljen, drugi se naporno vere preko bokova žene, ali mu je uspon otežan time što mu je treći zagazio tabanom na obraz (I), pa zato pravi grimasu boli, treći je dosegnuo cili i nježno obgrlio vrat žene, pa se blaženo smješka, tak

Hapomena: smještaj originala: apsida katedrale sv. Jakova, Šibenik

Opis: Na vijencu triju apsida i dijelu sjeverne fasade prema trgu, isklesana je 71 kamena ljudska glava, gotovo u naravnoj veličini, i tri lavlje glave. Samo njih četrdeset djelo su Jurja Dalmatinca, a ostale su radovi njegovih suradnika, dok je njih 14 zamijenjeno prilikom obnove 1850, godine slabijim klesarskim radovima. Ovim realizmom i humanizmom lica može se doživjeti i snaga Jurjeva izraza, njegova kiparska sposobnost u oblikovanju volumena glave, snažno pokrenute kose i uvjerljivih životnih izraza lica.
